EXECUTIVE SUMMARY NAISMITH CONTRACT (TULE CREEK WEST PROJECT)

The original Contract amount covers foreseeable costs associated with engineering, administration and construction management. Costs for the bridge and kiosk and trails will be developed through solicitation of bids and presentation to the Court for approval. Upon Court approval, the Naismith Contract amount will be increased to cover the cost of these individual procurement actions. The estimated final value of this Contract is \$205,000. In the event that separate contracts are issued by the County to cover purchase of project components, the Naismith Contract value will be unchanged.
