Pam Heard: Basically, this is our public hearing that we have to do every year, this statute says in order for me to charge this fee that we have to have the Commissioners Court to approve it. It's the same plan as in years past, I have to preserve my historical records, anything from 1950 and before, so in order to collect that money we have this \$10.00 fee. It's usually about \$2,000 a year that we collect and it's very expensive to have the books redone so, if we didn't charge this fee then it would be up to the Commissioner Court to budget it and it would have to come from the general fund, so it's sort of a win/win, the people who use the system are the ones who are paying \$10.00 in their court costs and that's usually about \$270.00, so this is a fee to help me restore my records.
