

MINUTES OF THE

SPECIAL MEETING - NOVEMBER 16, 2012

On the 16th day of November, 2012, there was a Special Meeting of the Commissioner' Court in the Courthouse, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, with the following members present: C. H. "Burt" Mills, Jr., County Judge; Jack Chaney, Commissioner, Precinct 1; Charles Smith, Commissioner, Precinct 3; and Peggy L. Friebele, County Clerk. Other elected officials present were Richard Bianchi, County Attorney; Alma Cartwright, County Treasurer; Diana McGinnis, Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2; and Pam Heard, District Clerk. The Meeting was convened at 9:00 a.m. at which time a quorum was declared by County Judge Mills, WHEREUPON, the meeting was begun and completed in the County Courtroom the following proceedings were had and done to wit:

CANVASS BALLOTS - GENERAL ELECTION

County Clerk Friebele explained the total registered voter amount was 15,405 when she ordered the ballots in September; however, by the time the election actually occurred there were 15,881 registered voters. This difference was displayed in the unofficial election returns presented for canvassing.

After review of the returns, motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Chaney to accept the reports of votes cast declaring results.
