PROCLAMATION #P-07-2011
DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR ARANSAS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Aransas on the 23rd of November, 2011, is under imminent threat of financial and economic impact on the seafood industry, specifically shrimp and oysters, due to:

DROUGHT RELATED RED TIDE; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY JUDGE of Aransas County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF ARANSAS COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby proclaimed for Aransas County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this Declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners' Court of Aransas County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Aransas County.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this Declaration of the local state of disaster activates the **Aransas County Emergency Management Plan**.

This Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance, **ORDERED THIS 23RD DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2011.**
