David Reid: The road condition was assessed by County Staff, there is a copy of it and we really just got this put together in time to get it on the agenda for this meeting and specifically for the grant money, but I would be glad to get you a copy of it.

4. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Chaney to approve Acceptance of County Road Administrator's Aransas County 2020 Annual Road Conditions Report.

CONTRACTS, AGREEMENTS, GRANTS & LEASES

6. Motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve allowing the Aransas County Animal Control Director to seek and apply for Pet Smart Charities grant. This grant is aimed at increasing health opportunities for chronically under-resourced pets and their people by facilitating the delivery of accessible basic veterinary care.

7. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Chaney to approve allowing the Aransas County Animal Control Director to seek and apply for "Seresto"

Circle of Love" grants 2020, sponsored by Adopt-A-Pet.com. They will be giving away \$100,000 in Seresto product grants. Seresto collars can help keep dogs and cats protected from fleas and ticks for 8 continuous months.

(Commissioner Smith suggested that Mike Geer talk to the County Attorney about possibly getting a written commitment.)

9. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Casterline to approve and authorize the County Judge to sign an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Rockport regarding Texas Commission on Environmental

Quality (TCEQ) grant funds budgeted from RESTORE ACT BUCKET 1 grant program for final engineering and shoreline restoration along Bay Shore Drive.

10. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Casterline to approve and authorize the County Judge to sign an Assignment Agreement with the City of Rockport and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to assign full ownership and control of the Subgrantfunded improvements contemplated in the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the City of Rockport for Bay Shore Drive Final Engineering and Shoreline Restoration upon their completion.

11. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Chaney to approve awarding bid for new fuel pumps and fuel management software systems to D&H United Fueling Solutions.

Motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve and authorize the IT Department to seek competitive sealed bids to replace end of life Wireless Networking Infrastructure components in use in several county facilities; the expected project costs are budgeted in the current fiscal year budget.

The new position is necessary in order to assist with an influx of workload when department re-opens to IN-PERSON transactions along with new state laws and Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TX DMV) procedures currently being implemented regarding issuance of license plates for off-highway vehicles and golf carts, additional monitoring required to identify and combat fraud, waste, and abuse;

and having webDEALER program in place by September 1st. [Tabled from 4/27/2020]

Question. Motion carried unanimously.


