Motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve eliminating all building permit fees on repairs to existing structures until April 20, 2019, and also to reimburse any building permit fees issued on existing structures from August 25, 2017 to present, upon request by owners, in order to hasten recovery efforts in the aftermath of Hurricane Harvey.
