Patrick Flanigan, 156th District Judge: Presented OCA report on District Court activity with chart break down on dispositions by County (Counties with population equal to Aransas County).


Betty Stiles: Thank you all for the wonderful words in the notes I received, I have enjoyed my six years as Commissioner and I will still be attending meetings after my retirement.
