COMMISSIONERS' COURT

REGULAR MEETING - AUGUST 17, 2015

On the 17th day of August, 2015, there was a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners' Court in the Courthouse, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, with the following members present: C. H. - 3. Report Receipt of the 2014 General Tax Fund Levy from Aransas County Tax Assessor and Record in Commissioners' Court Minutes stipulating 8% of the gross revenue tax levy (GRLT) for the Aransas County Indigent Health Care Program Fiscal Year September 1, 2015 August 31, 2016.
