

MINUTES OF THE

COMMISSIONERS' COURT

PUBLIC HEARING - FEBRUARY 11, 2013

On the 11th day of February, 2013, there was a Public Hearing of the Commissioners' Court held in the Commissioners' Court, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, with the following members present: C. H. "Burt" Mills, Jr., County Judge; Jack Chaney, Commissioner Precinct 1; Leslie "Bubba" Casterline, Commissioner, Precinct 2; Charles Smith, Commissioner Precinct 3; Betty Stiles, Commissioner, Precinct 4; and Peggy L. Friebele, County Clerk.

Other County Official present was Richard Bianchi, County Attorney; Alma Cartwright, County Treasurer; Bill Mills, Sheriff; David Vyoral, Road Administrator; David Reid, Drainage Engineer; Gene Johnson, Airport Manager; Jerry Brundrett, County Surveyor. and Lezlie Kirk, County Auditor.

The Meeting was convened at 8:45 a.m. at which time a quorum was declared by Judge Mills, WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had and done to wit:

Judge Mills stated the purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comment on the renaming of FM 1781 in Aransas County.

Judge Mills reported the State has taken down the FM 1781 signs since the County owns the portion of FM 1781 from FM 3036 to Highway 35N. The State will no longer be maintaining the road. County Clerk asked if the County could just put up signs saying FM 1781 and was told by Commissioner Stiles we cannot. It was Commissioner Stiles' suggestion, and she said the Post Office concurred, that the road be named "Highway 1781."

No further business presenting, the Court adjourned was adjourned by Commissioner Smith duly seconded by Commissioner Casterline.
