

MINUTES OF THE
COMMISSIONERS' COURT

PUBLIC HEARING - AUGUST 27, 2012

On the 27th day of August, 2012, there was a Public Hearing of the Commissioner' Court in the Courthouse, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, with the following members present: C. H. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON THE 2012 TAX INCREASE

No public comments were heard. Tax Assessor-Collector Cox gave a statement that she had few calls concerning the increase. She was able to calculate the total tax increase for one property owner in The Preserve and they were "ok" with the increased amount.
