8. Motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve Resolution #R-12-2017 designation Administration Service Providers for the 2017-2018 Texas Community Development Block Grant (TXCDBG) Colonia Fund Project.

Motion was made by Judge Mills and seconded by Commissioner Casterline to TABLE (To be placed on the July 24, 2017 agenda) authorizing the County Judge to enter into and sign the Renewal Agreement with Texas Association of Counties for Employee Health Insurance for the 2017-2018 plan year. Question. Motion carried unanimously. It is so ordered.

10. Motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve authorizing the County Judge to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between AEP Texas and Aransas County pertaining to AEP's SCORE/CitySmart Program, aimed at improving the energy efficiency of local government facilities.

- 11. Motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve Tax Assessor/Collector's request to award one-step or two-step increases to qualifying employees following administration of performance evaluations. No step increases have been given since April, 2015. Change in salaries will require only 1/3 of the surplus that is available in that department's budget line. Question. Motion carried unanimously. It is so ordered.
- 12. Motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve County District Attorney to accept a \$2,500 donation from the University of Texas for research assistance given to the Institute on Domestic Violence & Sexual Assault. Question. Motion carried unanimously. It is so ordered.
- 13. Motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve the addition of Aransas County

Children's Foundation to the available programs to which jurors may donate their jury service payments. Question. Motion carried unanimously.

14. Motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Casterline to approve allocating the Unclaimed Funds Capital Credits from Electric Co-ops, received from the State Comptroller, to the Literacy Programs offered at the Aransas County Public Library and to the Aransas County Children's Foundation, per LGC 381.004. Question. Motion carried unanimously.

It is so ordered.

Alma Cartwright, County Treasurer, proposed that the amount of \$3,904.10 be divided with \$1,300 going to the Literacy Programs and \$2,600 going to the Children's Foundation. Commissioner Chaney made a motion to amend his motion to include this proposal and Commissioner Casterline seconded the motion.

15. Motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Olsen to approve the distribution of \$135,459 of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service Refuge Revenue Sharing Act annual payments to Local Governments for lands under their administration for Fiscal Year 2016 received in 2017. Question. Motion carried unanimously.
