Bethany Jackson, Virginia Easton Smith, and Darla Zuniga came before the court with an update on the Aransas County 4H Program which is run by the agriculture extension office. At present there are five (5) clubs with twenty-five (25) adult volunteers and 78 children. The program teaches kids life and leadership skills, food and nutrition, cooking and baking, archery, public speaking, kayaking, livestock care, marine science, etc. A new and very popular program this year is livestock judging and they will be implementing a dog obedience training program this coming spring. The 4H club teaches children about giving back to the community through service projects and this year they had a beach clean-up campaign; bake sales with proceeds donated to the Coastal Bend Troop Support; and food drives for the Good Samaritans. Nine year old 4H member, Faith Purtell, told the court she is making doll clothes for the A&H show this next year.
