COMMISSIONERS' COURT

Order No. O-20-2020

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER APPROVING EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS, DATES AND TIMES, AND ELECTION DAY VOTING LOCATIONS AND AMENDING VOTING BY MAIL INFORMATION FOR ARANSAS COUNTY FOR THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Aransas County, Texas (the "Commissioners Court"), at the meeting held August 13, 2020, ordered a special bond election to be held on November 3, 2020 (the "Bond Election") to issue bonds of said County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has the authority pursuant to Chapter 85, Texas Election Code to designate early voting locations, dates, and times for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has authority pursuant to Chapter 43, Texas Election Code to designate the election day polling locations for the County; and

WHEREAS, the name and email address of the Early Voting Clerk for the Election have changed and need to be updated for the convenience of those voters requesting a ballot by mail; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the Commissioners Court to supplement and amend the Order Calling the Bond Election for the County, approved by the Commissioners Court at a meeting held on August 13, 2020.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. Preamble Incorporation. The recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby found to be true, and such recitals are hereby made a part of this Order for all purposes and are adopted as part of the judgment and findings of the Commissioners Court.

Section 2. Approval of Early Voting Polling Places, Dates and Times. The Commissioners Court hereby establishes the early voting dates, times and locations, for the

County's Bond Election as set out in Exhibit "A" to this Order, which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes.

Section 3. Approval of Election Day Polling Places. The Commissioners Court hereby establishes election day polling locations for the County's Bond Election as set out in Exhibit "B" to this Order, which is incorporated herein by reference for all purposes.

Section 4. Early Voting by Mail. Ballot applications shall be addressed to the Early Voting Clerk at the following address

An original, signed, complete application for a ballot by mail can be emailed to kstroud@aransascounty.org. If you are submitting your application for ballot by mail by fax or email, the original, hard copy of the application MUST be mailed and received by the early voting clerk no later than the 4th business day after it was originally submitted.

Section 5. Notice of Meeting. The Commissioners Court officially finds, determines, recites and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Order was adopted was posted on a bulletin board located at a place convenient to the public at the County's Courthouse for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of the meeting, that notice of such meeting was given to all news media who have consented to pay any and all expenses incurred by the County in connection with providing such notice; both as required by the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code as amended; and that such meeting was open to the public, as required by law at all times during which this Order and the subject matter thereof was discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The Governor has suspended and modified certain open meeting requirements pursuant to his disaster declaration. These changes include allowing the County to establish procedures for telephonic or video-conferenced meetings that are accessible to the public.

Section 6. Necessary Actions. The County Judge and the County Elections Administrator, in consultation with the County Attorney and bond counsel, are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of the Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act in carrying out and conducting the Election, whether or not expressly authorized herein, including making changes or additions to polling places or procedures to the extent required or desirable or as may become necessary due to circumstances arising after the date of this Order.

Section 7. Inconsistent Provisions. All orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Order shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordered herein.


Section 8. Governing Law. This Order shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the Orders and Resolutions of Aransas County, Texas, and the laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America.


Section 9. Severability. If any provision of this Order or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Order and the supplication of such provision to other persons and circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and the Commissioners Court hereby declares that this Order would have been enacted without such invalid provision.



The County Judge is authorized to execute and the County Clerk is authorized to attest this Order on behalf of the Commissioners Court; and the County Judge is authorized to do all other things legal and necessary in connection with the holding and consummation of the Election.

Section 11. Effective Date. This Order is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.




